WHO?

The course is designed for first line managers, those who have, or are looking to gain supervisory responsibilities

WHAT WE AIM TO DO:

At the end of the course, you will have an understanding of how health and safety law is structured, how to carry out risk assessments, site inspections and toolbox talks. You will be able to identify the need for proactive and reactive monitoring, and understand the difference.

WHAT WE WILL COVER:

The syllabus is prescribed by the CITB and includes:

Health and Safety law, Fire prevention, Risk Assessments, Method Statements, Manual Handling, First Aid, CDM, Hazardous Substances, Working at Height, PPE, Accident Prevention and Occupational health.

Successful candidate will be awarded the Nationally recognised CITB Site Supervisors Safety Training Scheme (SSSTS) certificate.
